

Triway High School Music Department

This past summer the Triway School district located in Wooster, Ohio completed a much needed renovation of their music department.

The Band and Choir Rooms were completely reconfigured, and the existing exit corridor was converted to an instrument storage room.

The seating risers were demolished in the Band and Choir Rooms, leveling the floors and improving ADA accessibility.

An exit ramp was created for the Band Room allowing the students a more direct route to the practice field.

Because the existing music rooms were not previously air conditioned and the existing heating equipment was at the end of its life, replacement of the HVAC system was needed.

New equipment closets were created in each music area to house vertical hydronic heat/DX cooling air handling units.

With 130 people occupying both Band and Choir, an Energy Recovery Unit was installed to provide pre-conditioned outdoor air to each new air handling system. Ventilation is now greatly improved, and the school district is now enjoying an air-conditioned space.
