

Zimmermann Symphony Center

HEI Engineering Group is pleased to be a part of the \$5.4 million Zimmermann Symphony Center on the southwest corner of McKinley High School which gives the Canton Symphony a new home.

Handsome, spacious and full of natural light, with a total of 22,000 square feet on three levels, the facility expands the symphony's options considerably.

There is a music library, a board room, two large storage rooms, a reception desk, an audio-visual engineering studio, a gallery space for exhibits and an elevator connecting the center's three levels.

There is a new lobby for concert attendees, and a 250-capacity Foundation Hall with wood floors, high ceiling and a curved wall of windows where receptions, dinners and recitals can be held.

The HVAC design includes three (3) VVT gas fired heating and electric cooling rooftop units for a total capacity of 50 Tons. The individual zones are served by single duct
